RATES OF USE

There are two different VALIDATE use rates dependent upon the pesticide it is used with.

USE	PGR, BLW Herbicides, Insecticides and Fungicides	MSO/mineral oil replacement
Water Volume (litres per ha)	0.25%	0.5%
70	175ml	350ml
100	250ml	500ml
200	500ml	1000ml

MIXING

Half fill spray tank with water and start agitation. Add required quantity of VALIDATE before any pesticide. Add pesticide(s) as directed. Continue agitation while topping up the tank and during spraying.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

VALIDATE may be used at a maximum concentration of 0.5% on the following crops, up to the growth stages specified, with all approved pesticides applied up to their full approved rate.

Crop	Growth Stages before which VALIDATE may be used with approved pesticides
Cereals	up to and including GS 52 (1/4 inflorescence)
Oilseed rape	up to and including 10% potential pods
Broad bean dwarf French bean field bean runner bean	up to and including first pod set
Combining pea and vining pea	up to and including flat pod (non-edible pods only)
Edible podded pea	up to and including pod set
Linseed	up to and including 10% capsules formed
Forage Maize	up to and including tip of tassel visible
Sugar beet	up to and including 6 fully expanded leaves
Potato	up to and including tuber initiation
Brussels sprout	up to and including lateral buds begin to develop
Cauliflower	up to and including cauliflower heads begin to form; width of growing tip up to 1 cm ²
Apple and pear	up to and including fruit 5-10 mm

In addition to the above, VALIDATE is authorised for use with all approved pesticides on all edible crops provided that the statutory conditions of use for the pesticide are followed and that the pesticide is not used at more than 50% of the maximum approved rate for that application. VALIDATE is authorised for use with all approved pesticides on all non-edible crops provided that the statutory conditions of use for the pesticide are followed.

VALIDATE may be used in tank mixture with trace and with macro elements to improve coverage and uptake in a wide variety of crops.

VALIDATE may be used to reduce drift of sprays where this is a concern.

Do not use in mixes with other adjuvant oils or surfactants, or if conditions are not recommended for the partner pesticide or trace element.
